Cincinnati's Largest Pet Adoption Event Returns to Sharonville Convention Center

CINCINNATI – My Furry Valentine, Greater Cincinnati's largest pet adoption event, returns to the Sharonville Convention Center on Saturday, Feb. 15 & 16 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.* The ninth annual mega-adoption event connects hundreds of animals with new owners by bringing more than 25 rescues and shelters together Valentine's Day weekend.

Since the event started in 2012, My Furry Valentine has significantly reduced the number of animals killed in shelters by helping more than 6,000 dogs, cats, puppies, kittens and other furry friends find loving homes. This year's family-friendly event will feature over 900 adoptable animals under one roof and offers gift bags and discounted adoption fees for adopters, and kid's activities and a chance to win multiple raffle prizes for all visitors.
